TUGUEGARAO BRANCH RELEASES HIGHEST TAX IN PAG-IBIG HISTORY

Pag-IBIG Tuguegarao Branch released to Mr. Juanito Calubaquib, an employee of the City Government of Tuguegarao, the amount of Php 1.2 Million representing his savings over the years as Pag-IBIG member – the highest savings withdrawn in the 33-year history of the Fund.

This is a result of the effective efforts of the Tuguegarao Branch’s Marketing and Enforcement Group in encouraging members to save money with the Fund by contributing more than the required P100 minimum savings.

Mr. Calubaquib was encouraged to increase his contributions because of Tuguegarao Branch office’s promotion of Pag-IBIG savings as an investment and a secure savings upon retirement.

In February 2005, Mr. Calubaquib started increasing his monthly Pag-IBIG contributions from P100 to P1,900. He continued saving wisely until his contribution reached P20,000 per month in January 2009.

“Mas mabuti ng nai-deposit na dyan kaysa magastos ko pa. At least kumikita siya at pwede kong gamitin in the future,” Mr. Calubaquib said.

His savings with the Fund reached a total of P1.6 Million, with an earned dividends of P234,000.

Mr. Calubaquib said he intends to invest a portion of the amount he received in the Modified Pag-IBIG II Membership program.

Meanwhile, the Marketing and Enforcement Group is relentless in its campaign for increased contributions and Modified Pag-IBIG II membership resulting in Tuguegarao Branch’s consistent Top 3 ranking in MC Collections.
